**Reading from gospel writer Matthew**

Jesus saw people crowd, felt sorry-pity. Themselves seem tired,

alone — same-as sheep without shepherd. Jesus told disciples:

“There many, many people to harvest (save). But workers...FEW. Ask

God send more-more workers help gather people.”

Jesus called 12 disciples, gave-them power for remove evil spirits and heal sick. 12 apostles names: Peter; his brother, Andrew; James; his brother, John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew; James; Thaddeus; Simon; last — Judas, himself betrayed Jesus.

Jesus sent these 12 men for teaching, said: “Don’t visit areas not Jewish...Go-to people Israel, themselves same-as lost sheep. Preach what?? ‘Kingdom of God coming soon—will!’ People sick, you help heal. People dead, you help raise. Lepers heal; demons out. You receive gift, now give free.”
