Reading from gospel writer Mark

(response) GLORY TO YOU, LORD (+ forehead, +lips, +heart, +hands)

Some pharisees, also lawyers, came-up to Jesus. They noticed Jesus his disciples eat without washing hands. (Remember: Pharisees, all Jews, follow tradition: never eat without washing hands carefully. Also, never eat food from market without washing very carefully. Have other traditions also: wash cups, jugs, pots carefully.) So, Pharisees asked Jesus: "Why your disciples not follow traditions, instead eat without washing their hands, why?"

Jesus said: "Isaiah prophet explained about you when he wrote:

This people praises me,

but their hearts, closed.

Their worship false

Because they teach human laws, not God's law.

You ignore God his commandment, instead focus on human tradition.

Jesus called people and said: "Pay-attention-to-me. Try to understand.

Nothing from outside person can make person not clean; only things inside make person not clean. Pay attention!"
